### **009 – 2010 Parent Involvement Policy**

Green Run Elementary commits to promoting strong parental involvement through the following activities:

- Initiatives that involve parents and families in supporting their children's learning will include: parent /teacher conferences, Open House, scheduled grade level programs on PTA nights, and parent workshops supporting various academic areas. These activities will be offered at various times of the day. Title I Open House, held on October 23 at 9:00 a.m., will inform parents how they can be involved at Green Run Elementary.
- Ongoing two-way communications between parents and teachers will be provided through teacher reports, conferencing, e-mails, newsletters, home/neighborhood visits, and the school website. If special communications or accommodations are needed, every reasonable effort will be made to meet those needs.
- Teachers will follow the curriculum provided by Virginia Beach City Public Schools; which can be found on-line at [www.vbschools.com](http://www.vbschools.com) and can be reviewed at each school site. Parents will be provided with results of their child's performance as directed by the Virginia Beach City Public Schools. Methods will include report cards, progress reports, phone calls from teachers, and graded papers sent home. Results of assessments administered by the division to measure student performance will be provided to parents in writing, including a description of the results and proficiency expectations.
- Parents serving on the School Planning Council, Title I staff, and school administrators will be involved in the planning, review, and implementation of the Title I Parent Involvement Policy and the Title I Compact for Green Run Elementary. The Title I Compact is distributed to all Green Run families, and it will require signatures of the principal, teachers, parents/guardians, and students. The Title I Parent Involvement Policy will be posted on the school website, will be distributed to each family, and will be amended annually based on the needs of the school community. If the Title I Parent Involvement Policy or Title I Compact is not satisfactory, parents may submit their comments and/or suggestions to the district Title I department. All parents can attend the district's Title I Parent Review Committee meetings.
