It is important to check the starred items frequently to see if they need to be replenished.

**Kindergarten**

- Backpack or book bag (large) with name clearly labeled on it
- 1 Package of each of the following: *Ziploc bags- Gallon, Sandwich, and Snack Size*
- 2 Boxes of tissues
- 1 Bottle hand sanitizer
- 1 Package of disinfecting wipes

*Please mark (with a permanent marker) your child's name on all of your child's clothing and belongings.*

*The following items need to be at home in order for your child to do homework assignments: crayons, glue, scissors, and paper, old magazines to use to cut pictures, pencils, and index cards.*

**First Grade**

- \*24 - No. 2 pencils (will be collected)
- 1 School box (approx. 8 in. x 5 in.)
- 2 Plain **plastic** folders with 2 pockets, no brads
- 1 Box of *Ziploc* bags (girls-sandwich, boys-gallon)
- 2 Large boxes of tissues (will be collected)
- 4 Black/white marble composition notebooks
- 8 Glue sticks
- 2 white, 1-1/2 inch, three ring binder with clear pocket on front and pockets inside

- 1 Large shoe box with lid (will be used as an "At Home Library". This is needed the first week of school. )
- Disinfecting wipes (boys)
- Large bottle hand sanitizer (girls)

*The following items need to be at home in order for your child to do homework assignments: crayons, glue stick, scissors, and pencils.*

**Second Grade**

- \*32 - #2 plain yellow pencils, with erasers (will be collected)
- 3 Black and white composition notebooks
- 4 Large boxes of tissues
- 2 Boxes *Ziploc* bags (quart-size – BOYS and gallon-size – GIRLS)
- 2 **Black** dry erase markers – non-toxic – (will be collected) – PLEASE –no colored markers
- White board eraser
- 6 glue sticks (will be collected)
- 2 Packs of loose leaf paper – wide ruled
- 3 – plastic 3-prong/pocket folders
- 1 8-oz. bottle hand sanitizer (girls only)
- 1 Pkg. disinfecting wipes (boys only)
- **No Scissors (scissors will be provided), Trapper Keepers, or wire-bound notebooks.**

### **Third Grade**

- 2 Pkgs. of wide-ruled notebook paper (NOT college-ruled paper, please)
- 72-#2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- 3 Large boxes of tissues
- 1 Box of sandwich-size *Ziploc* bags
- 1 Composition notebook (black-and-white)
- 1 Box of multiplication flash cards
- 2 Dry erase markers (black, non-toxic, low-odor)
- 1 White board eraser

### **Fourth Grade**

- \*Loose-leaf notebook paper (3 packages - not college-ruled)

- **Zippered** pencil pouch (**no plastic boxes**)
- Tissues (3 large boxes)
- 1 Box *Ziploc* bags (quart size)
- 3 -one-subject spiral notebooks
- 3 – three-prong folders

- 1 Box of colored pencils
- 1 Zipper pencil case w/ 3 holes
- Glue sticks
